

MULTIPLE PERIAPICAL RADIOLUCENCIES: DIAGNOSIS ?



FINDINGS: PATIENT ASYMPTOMATIC WITH NO HISTORY OF PAIN OR TRAUMA. ALL TEETH RESPONDED TO BOTH COLD AND ELECTRIC PULP TESTING. NO SWELLING, MOBILITY OR BONE EXPANSION. NO RESTORATIVE HISTORY OR CARIES. SOFT TISSUES AND PERIODONTAL POCKETS WITHIN NORMAL LIMITS.

DIAGNOSIS: # 23, # 24, # 25

PULPAL: NORMAL FOR EACH TOOTH

PATHOLOGY: PERIAPICAL CEMENTO-OSSEOUS DYSPLASIA

TREATMENT PLAN: NO TREATMENT IS INDICATED, BUT ONE YEAR FOLLOW-UP TO MONITOR THE PERIAPICAL AREA.
